The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) provide globally accepted objectives for both policy makers and businesses in their pursuit for more sustainability. The incoming European Commission, led by President Ursula von der Leyen, has made clear that sustainable development will be the "North Star" in the coming five years, and an ambitious Green New Deal is being launched, with a strong reliance on technologies such as Artificial intelligence and the Internet of Things. The latter, in particular, provides technological means to help attaining many of the SDGs, and appears to be essential in domains like agriculture, manufacturing, mobility, energy and healthcare.
